Supported by music leader Naomi and volunteer helper Holly the group performed a variety of original Music Man Project songs, some Christmas carols and there was a special performance from musician Josh, who together with Holly sang Ed Sheeran's Castle on the Hill. Since we launched in April the group have not only learnt 9 new Music Man Project songs but the musicians have also been learning to play instruments and sign along with the music. They have all done incredibly well and the concert was a wonderful showcase of all that they have achieved.

We were delighted to see over 80 people turn up on the night to watch the show, a mix of family, friends and supporters. The hall was packed full and the musicians enjoyed performing to a full audience. The audience members were encouraged to join in with actions and singing along and a great time was had by all.

The musicians have been invited to take part in a huge performance as part of the wider Music Man Project family and will be part of an incredible show at the Royal Albert Hall in April 2019. Over 200 people with learning disabilities, along with massed choirs and an orchestra will be performing in 'Music is Magic'. See our website for details.

The Christmas concert raised a whopping £557.65 which will go a long way towards travel and accommodation costs for the group to take part in this incredible event.


