ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING Notice of Cancellation

The Society's Annual General Meeting is usually held in June each year in order to present an update of our activities and the year end accounts. This year the trustees would have presented the accounts up to the end of March 2020. Clearly that hasn't been possible this year as the nation was in lockdown, so the trustees postponed the AGM, hoping to re-arrange it at the end of the lockdown. Restrictions were eased, but not enough for our members to safely gather, for what is also a social occasion. We are now in another lockdown, with no ability to hold a face-to-face AGM for some time to come. Therefore, after a lot of thought, the trustees have decided to cancel the AGM for 2020. The decision has been taken in line wit guidance issued by the Charities Commission.

Meanwhile, the Society's accounts for the year to end of March 2020 have been examined by external accountants, and the Report & Accounts for the year have been submitted to the Charity Commission. 


Christmas Appeal


